Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone 7921G Desktop Charger	The desktop charger has a built-in speakerphone and allows you to charge the phone with an attached battery as well as to charge an extra battery. This new combination charger and speakerphone stand provides enhanced desktop capability. The desktop charger uses a different power supply than the phone. Please note that the phone power supply is not required when using the desktop charger. The desktop charger is not currently available in Brazil.	
Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone 7921G Multi-Charger	The multi-charger is ideal for environments in which users have multiple shifts and must keep their Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phones 7921G charged throughout the day. The multi-charger can charge up to six phones and six phone batteries simultaneously. Its flexible design allows the unit to be placed on a desk or mounted on a wall to save space.	
Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone 7921G Leather Case	The leather carrying case has a clear plastic window that allows you to view the screen and provides easy access to the keys and buttons. The carrying case has a removable belt clip on the back that rotates 360 degrees. This case comes with a security cord. The ring on one end of the cord slides onto the D-ring on the back of the carrying case. You can fasten the other end of the cord to a belt loop to secure the phone. The multi-charger will be available in Q1CY09.

Product	Description	
Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone Lock Set	The lock set can be used to secure the phone to a desk or other furniture after hours and on weekends.	
Standard A-type to B-type 48-inch USB cable	You can use the standard A-type to B-type USB cable to connect your computer to a Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone that is in the desktop charger. You can charge your Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone while simultaneously transmitting data between the Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone and your computer. Cisco does not supply the standard A-type to B-type USB cable; you must purchase this standard USB cable at your local electronics supply source.	
Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone Shoulder Strap for Leather Case	A shoulder strap is available for carrying your Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phone. After removing the belt clip from the back of the leather carrying case, you can slide the phone onto the holder. You can use a small clip on the bottom of the phone holder to secure the phone and strap to your clothing. A quick-release buckle makes it easy to remove the shoulder strap quickly.	
Wired headsets	The Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phones support tri-band four-conductor 2.5-mm-plug headsets and ear buds. The audio portion of a headset must sound good to the user and to the party on the far end. Sound is subjective, and Cisco cannot guarantee the performance of any headsets, but some of the headsets at the sites listed here have been reported to perform well on Cisco Unified Wireless IP Phones.
